5 WHEREAS, on March 1, 2009, Lee's Friends, a nationally acclaimed cancer support group, will
7 celebrate the organization's 30th anniversary; and

8 WHEREAS, formed by admirers of Lee Harkins of Norfolk, who was only 16 when she died of 9 Hodgkin's disease in 1978, Lee's Friends was established as a charitable trust in her name to sustain 10 services for other cancer sufferers; and

11 WHEREAS, Lee's Friends is a network of trained lay and professional volunteers who offer comfort 12 for cancer patients and their families; and

WHEREAS, Lee's Friends offers emotional support from trained volunteers, free transportation to
 medical appointments, emergency financial assistance, and special events; and

WHEREAS, in 1982 Lee's Friends was recognized by President Ronald Reagan as one of 16
nationwide organizations to receive the President's Volunteer Action Award; in addition, it has received
numerous other awards over the past 30 years, including those from the Commonwealth of Virginia, the
National Conference of Christians and Jews, the National Congress on Cancer Survivorship, and the
Hampton Roads Volunteer Achievement Award; and

20 WHEREAS, Lee's Friends now has more than 350 volunteers and has established an endowment for
 21 the organization; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 commend and congratulate Lee's Friends on the occasion of its 30th anniversary; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution
