| 11<br>12    | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:<br>1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 26 of Title 2.2 an article  |
| 13          | numbered 34, consisting of sections numbered 2.2-2699.3 through 2.2-2699.6 as follows:   |
| 14          | Article 34.  |
| 15          | P-16 Education Council.  |
| 16          | § 2.2-2699.3. P-16 Education Council; purpose.   |
| 17          | The P-16 Education Council (the Council) is established as an advisory council, within the meaning   |
| 18          | of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Council is to make  |
| 19          | recommendations on ways to create a seamless transition and ensure effective articulation from   |
| 20          | preschool to graduate school.  |
| 21          | § 2.2-2699.4. Membership; terms; quorum; meetings.   |
| 22          | The Council shall be composed of 21 members. Four members of the House of Delegates shall be   |
| 23          | appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, in accordance with the principles of proportional  |
| 24          | representation contained in the Rules of the House of Delegates, and two members of the Senate shall   |
| 25          | be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. The Governor shall appoint eight citizen members who  |
| 26          | shall include educators, and business and community leaders. The Council shall also include the  |
| 27          | Secretary of Education, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Executive Director of the State  |
| 28          | Council of Higher Education, the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System, the President  |
| 29          | of the Board of Education, the Chairman of the Virginia Community College Board, and the Chairman  |
| 30          | of the State Council of Higher Education.  |
| 31          | Appointments of legislative members and heads of agencies or representatives of organizations shall  |
| 32          | be for terms consistent with their terms of office. All other appointments of nonlegislative members shall   |
| 33          | be for terms of three years, except an appointment to fill a vacancy, which shall be for the unexpired   |
| 34          | term. All members may be reappointed.  |
| 35          | The Secretary of Education shall chair the Council and the Council shall elect a vice-chairman from  |
| 36<br>37    | among its membership. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum. The meetings of the Council shall be held regularly at the call of the chairman or his designee.                              |
| 37<br>38    | § 2.2-2699.5. Powers and duties of the Council.  |
| 39          | The Council shall have the following powers and duties:  |
| <b>40</b>   | 1. Identify opportunities to better coordinate the state's education reform efforts from preschool to  |
| 41          | graduate school.   |
| 42          | 2. Develop approaches to improve transitions among levels of education, promote student success,   |
| 43          | and encourage students to continue their education.  |
| 44          | 3. Consider strategies for data systems that provide information about students at all educational   |
| 45          | levels.  |
| 46          | 4. Identify ways to expand access to early learning for children aged three to five, and improve their   |
| 47          | readiness for kindergarten.  |
| 48          | 5. Examine approaches to creating a wider range of learning experiences and opportunities for high   |
| <b>49</b>   | school students, and increasing college and workforce readiness and success.   |
| 50          | 6. Make investigations, issue annual reports to the Governor and the General Assembly, and make  |
| 51          | recommendations relevant to education upon the request of the Governor.  |
| 52          | § 2.2-2699.6. Staffing.  |
| 53<br>54    | The [ Department of Education Office of the Secretary of Education ] shall provide staff assistance  |
| 54<br>55    | to the Council. Additional assistance as needed shall be provided by the [Department of Education, the]  |
| 55<br>56    | Virginia Community College System, the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia, and the   |
| 56<br>57    | Department of Social Services. All agencies, authorities, and institutions of the Commonwealth shall cooperate and provide such assistance to the Council upon request.                                  |
| 57<br>58    | 2. That it is the intent of the General Assembly that nonlegislative members currently serving on  |
| 59          | the Council shall fulfill their terms, and subsequently be replaced according to the provisions of   |

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60 this Act.
