 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 5 of Chapter 9 of Title 18.2 a section numbered 18.2-423.2 as follows: 10
- § 18.2-423.2. Displaying noose on property of another or a highway or other public place with intent 11 12 to intimidate: penalty.
- A. Any person who, with the intent of intimidating any person or group of persons, displays a noose 13 14 on the private property of another without permission is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
- B. Any person who, with the intent of intimidating any person or group of persons, displays a noose 15 16 on a highway or other public place in a manner having a direct tendency to place another person in
- reasonable fear or apprehension of death or bodily injury is guilty of a Class 6 felony. 17
- 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 18
- commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot 19
- be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be 20
- determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice. 21
