13	§ 46.2-116. Leaving an unattended child in a motor vehicle; penalty.
14	A. Any driver or operator of a motor vehicle who leaves an unattended child in a motor vehicle is
	guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
16	B. A law-enforcement officer who observes or is alerted to the existence of an unattended child shall
17	use whatever means are reasonably necessary to protect the child. If the law-enforcement officer
18	removes the child from the immediate area, he shall leave an obvious written notice on the motor
19	vehicle. The law-enforcement officer shall give notice of the unattended child to Child Protective
20	Services.
21	C. "Unattended child" as used in this section means a child under six years of age who has been left
22	in a motor valida by the driver or energies of the valida when the driver or energies is wall to

in a motor vehicle by the driver or operator of the vehicle when the driver or operator is unable to
