

## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact §§ 15.2-2506 and 22.1-93, as it shall become effective on January 1,*  
3 *2009, of the Code of Virginia, relating to publication of the school division's annual school budget.*

5 Approved

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That §§ 15.2-2506 and 22.1-93, as it shall become effective on January 1, 2009, of the Code of**  
8 **Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:**

9 § 15.2-2506. Publication and notice; public hearing; adjournment; moneys not to be paid out until  
10 appropriated.

11 A brief synopsis of the budget which, except in the case of the school division budget, shall be for  
12 informative and fiscal planning purposes only, shall be published once in a newspaper having general  
13 circulation in the locality affected, and notice given of one or more public hearings, at least seven days  
14 prior to the date set for hearing, at which any citizen of the locality shall have the right to attend and  
15 state his views thereon. Any locality not having a newspaper of general circulation may in lieu of the  
16 foregoing notice provide for notice by written or printed handbills, posted at such places as it may  
17 direct. The hearing shall be held at least seven days prior to the approval of the budget as prescribed in  
18 § 15.2-2503. With respect to the school division budget, *which shall include the estimated required local*  
19 *match*, such hearing shall be held at least seven days prior to the approval of that budget as prescribed  
20 in § 22.1-93. The governing body may adjourn such hearing from time to time. The fact of such notice  
21 and hearing shall be entered of record in the minute book.

22 In no event, including school division budgets, shall such preparation, publication and approval be  
23 deemed to be an appropriation. No money shall be paid out or become available to be paid out for any  
24 contemplated expenditure unless and until there has first been made an annual, semiannual, quarterly or  
25 monthly appropriation for such contemplated expenditure by the governing body, except funds  
26 appropriated in a county having adopted the county executive form of government, outstanding grants  
27 may be carried over for one year without being reappropriated.

28 § 22.1-93. (Effective January 1, 2009) Approval of annual budget for school purposes.

29 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including but not limited to Chapter 25 (§ 15.2-2500 et  
30 seq.) of Title 15.2, the governing body of a county shall prepare and approve an annual budget for  
31 educational purposes by May first or within thirty days of the receipt by the county of the estimates of  
32 state funds, whichever shall later occur, and the governing body of a municipality shall prepare and  
33 approve an annual budget for educational purposes by May fifteen or within thirty days of the receipt by  
34 the municipality of the estimates of state funds, whichever shall later occur. Upon approval, each local  
35 school division shall publish the approved annual budget, *including the estimated required local match*,  
36 on the division's website, if any, or if there is no division website, the document shall otherwise be  
37 made available in hard copy as needed to citizens for inspection.

38 The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall, no later than the fifteenth day following final  
39 adjournment of the Virginia General Assembly in each session, submit estimates to be used for  
40 budgetary purposes relative to the Basic School Aid Formula to each school division and to the local  
41 governing body of each county, city and town that operates a separate school division. Such estimates  
42 shall be for each year of the next biennium or for the then next fiscal year.

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
