6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-79.4, relating to managing
7	students with life-threatening food allergies in public schools.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-79.4 as follows:
10	§ 22.1-79.4. Managing students with life-threatening allergies.
11	A. No later than January 1, 2010, each local school board shall develop and implement a policy for
12	the management of public school students with life-threatening food allergies. This policy shall be based
13	on the Department of Education's Special Care Issues Guidelines relating to food allergies and
14	anaphylaxis.
15	B. No later than July 1, 2010, each school board shall ensure that all school personnel having direct
16	contact with students receive appropriate training in the causes and prevention of food allergies, the

identification of symptoms indicating exposure to allergens, and the proper management of students who
