10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 24.2-238 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 24.2-238. Costs.
13	A. If a judicial proceeding under this article is dismissed in favor of the respondent, the court in its
14	discretion may require the state agency or political subdivision which the respondent serves to pay court
15	costs or reasonable attorney fees, or both, for the respondent.
16	B. No person who signs a petition for the removal of an official pursuant to § 24.2-233 or who
17	circulates such a petition (i) shall be liable for any costs associated with removal proceedings conducted
18	pursuant to the petition, including attorney fees incurred by any other party or court costs, or (ii) shall
19	have sanctions imposed against him pursuant to § 8.01-271.1. However, the court may assess such costs

20 21 or impose such sanctions upon its finding by clear and convincing evidence that the petitioner acted with a malicious intent to harm the official.
