3	A BILL to authorize the Virginia Marine Resources Commission to grant easements and rights-of-way
4 5	across and in the beds of the Elizabeth River, including a portion of the Baylor Survey, to the
5 6	Department of Transportation, for the improvement of the Midtown Tunnel.

9 10	Whereas, the Department of Transportation currently operates and maintains the Route 58 Midtown
11	Tunnel connecting the Cities of Norfolk and Portsmouth; and
12	Whereas, the population of the Hampton Roads region and traffic using the existing tunnel have
13	grown considerably since the existing facility opened in 1962; and
14	Whereas, the current facility is now the most heavily traveled two-lane road in the Commonwealth;
15	and the first first first had been been been been been been been bee
16 17	Whereas, the heavy use of the existing facility poses both safety and congestion problems; and
17 18	Whereas, the Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Hampton Roads Metropolitan Planning Organization, has determined that construction of a parallel tunnel would improve these
19	conditions; and
20	Whereas, a new facility will create employment and economic opportunities for the residents of
21	Norfolk and Portsmouth; and
22 23	Whereas, the federal government approved the environmental impact statement for the project in July 2007, and
23 24	2007; and Whereas, this location will cross the Baylor Survey Grounds Number 9, therefore necessitating an act
25	of the General Assembly; now, therefore,
26	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
27	1.§ 1. That the Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) is hereby authorized to grant and
28 29	convey to the Department of Transportation, its successors and assigns, upon such terms and conditions as VMRC, with the approval of the Governor and the Attorney General, shall deem proper, permanent
30	easements and rights-of-way and a temporary right-of-way of a reasonable width as needed for the
31	purpose of the construction of a second tunnel for the Route 58 Midtown Tunnel.
32	Situated along the Elizabeth River and being a part of the Baylor Ground designated "Public
33	Ground No. 9, Norfolk County (City of Norfolk)" as shown on a map compiled by the VMRC and being
34 35	a tract of property described as follows: Beginning at the southeastern-most point of said "Public Ground No. 9" said point having a
36	coordinate value of North 3,478,519.497, East 12,122,019.715. Coordinate values are based on Virginia
37	State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD 1983/1994 HARN, and expressed in U.S. Survey feet.
38	Thence, with the south line of "Public Ground No. 9," North 82° 21' 33" West, 275.71 feet to the TRUE
39	POINT OF BEGINNING; Thence, continuing with the south line of "Public Ground No. 9," North 82°
40	21' 33" West, 214.51 feet to the western shore line of the Elizabeth River; Thence, leaving the south line
41 42	of "Public Ground No. 9" and following the shore line of the Elizabeth River along tie-line courses as follows: North 26° 35' 51" East, 264.77 feet; North 49° 57' 34" East, 69.03 feet; North 37° 49' 29" East,
43	153.98 feet; North 21° 48' 42" West, 10.25 feet; North 72° 20' 10" West, 25.15 feet; North 88° 08' 55"
44	West, 15.17 feet; North 74° 22' 13" West, 13.96 feet; North 48° 14' 21" West, 140.79 feet; North 30° 32'
45	00" West, 24.43 feet; North 1° 43' 00" West, 19.67 feet; Thence, leaving the shore line of the Elizabeth
46	River, North 45° 25' 50" East, 671.67 feet to the eastern line of said "Public Ground No. 9," South 4°
47 48	23' 22" West, 766.60 feet; Thence, leaving the eastern line of said "Public Ground No. 9," South 45° 25' 50" West, 419.22 feet, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; and containing 6.653 acres, more or less.
49	§ 2. That the public interest of this project outweighs the public interest in maintaining the sanctity
50	of the Baylor Survey at this location, and this location only, because of its non-productivity for shellfish.
51	§ 3. None of the property described in § 1 that lies within the Baylor Survey shall be considered part
52 53	of the natural oyster beds, rocks, and shoals in the waters of the Commonwealth.
55 54	§ 4. The instrument granting and conveying the easements and rights-of-way from the Commonwealth to the Department of Transportation shall be in a form approved by the Attorney General.
55	§ 5. That the Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to permit uses of the easement and
56	right-of-way to a private entity developing and/or operating the Midtown Tunnel pursuant to the
57	Public-Private Transportation Act (§ 56-556 et seq.) of the Code of Virginia.

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
