Senate Amendments in [] — February 2, 2009

A BILL to amend and reenact § 54.1-703.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Board for Barbers and Cosmetology; estheticians; waiver of examination requirements.

Referred to Committee on General Laws and Technology

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 54.1-703.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 54.1-703.3. Waiver of examination; estheticians.

The Board shall waive the examination requirements for licensure as an esthetician or master esthetician for any individual who (i) makes application for licensure between July 1, [2007 2009], and July 1, 20082010; (ii) otherwise complies with Board regulations relating to moral turpitude; and (iii) meets any of the following conditions:

1. Has at least three years of documented work experience as an esthetician or a master esthetician [completed prior to July 1, 2008] that is deemed satisfactory by the Board;

2. Has completed a training program [prior to July 1, 2008] that is deemed satisfactory by the Board; or

3. Holds an unexpired certificate of registration, certification, or license as an esthetician or a master esthetician issued to him [prior to July 1, 2008] on the basis of comparable requirements by a proper authority of a state, territory, or possession of the United States, or the District of Columbia.
