### SENATE BILL NO. 1527

#### AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Health, Welfare and Institutions  
on February 17, 2009)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator McDougle)

*A BILL to amend and reenact § 54.1-703.3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to licensure of estheticians.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 54.1-703.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 54.1-703.3. Waiver of examination; estheticians.

The Board shall waive the examination requirements for licensure as an esthetician or master esthetician for any individual who (i) makes application for licensure ~~between July 1, 2007, and before July 1, 2008~~ *31, 2009*; (ii) otherwise complies with Board regulations relating to moral turpitude; and (iii) meets any of the following conditions:

1. Has at least three years of documented work experience as an esthetician or a master esthetician that is deemed satisfactory by the Board;

2. Has completed a training program that is deemed satisfactory by the Board; or

3. Holds an unexpired certificate of registration, certification, or license as an esthetician or a master esthetician issued to him on the basis of comparable requirements by a proper authority of a state, territory, or possession of the United States, or the District of Columbia.

**2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.**

**3. That the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation shall to the extent reasonably practicable, provide widespread notification to those affected by the provisions of this Act.**
