SENATE BILL NO. 527

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Transportation  
on January 24, 2008)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Houck)

*A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-1022 of the Code of Virginia, relating to flashing warning lights.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 46.2-1022 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 46.2-1022. Flashing blue, red and blue, blue and white, or red, white and blue warning lights.

Certain Department of Military Affairs vehicles and certain Virginia National Guard vehicles designated by the Adjutant General, when used in state active duty to perform particular law-enforcement functions, Department of Corrections vehicles designated by the Director of the Department of Corrections, *regional jail vehicles designated by the superintendent of the regional jail*, and law-enforcement vehicles may be equipped with flashing, blinking, or alternating blue, blue and red, blue and white, or red, white, and blue combination warning lights of types approved by the Superintendent.
