Commending Louise Archer Elementary School on the occasion of its 70th anniversary.

WHEREAS, originally named the Vienna Colored School, Louise Archer Elementary School was renamed in 1950 in honor of its first educator, Louise Archer, who began teaching students at the First Baptist Church sanctuary; and

WHEREAS, integrated in September 1965, Louise Archer Elementary School now serves as a positive learning environment for over 700 students and stands as a tribute to the unyielding efforts of Louise Archer to provide students the opportunity for academic and social success; and

WHEREAS, throughout its rich educational history, the Louise Archer Parents and Teachers Association sponsors numerous before and after school programs, clubs, field trips, and organizations, as well as provides a supportive and educational atmosphere for students to thrive; and

WHÊREAS, the students, faculty, and staff at Louise Archer Elementary School take pride in its history and the legacy of Louise Archer and work diligently to meet the diverse needs of the student population and empower all who walk through the school's doors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend Louise Archer Elementary School on its 70th anniversary; and, be it
