WHEREAS, Frances Daly graciously donated her time and talents as a volunteer for Hospice Support Services and was a member of the Wednesday Club, Garden Club, Widow's Club, Sertoma Club, Mellow Fellow's Club, and Catholic Women's Club; and

WHEREAS, Frances Daly lived her faith through her life and as a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, where she was active in the church's many missions in the community; and

WHEREAS, Frances Daly will be remembered for her kind and loving spirit and missed by her children, P. Niles, Patrick, Jon, James, Robert, Shelayne, and Charisse and their families; and her numerous friends and admirers; now, therefore, be it
