WHEREAS, when the office was reorganized, Verdia Haywood became the first deputy county executive for Human Services, a position he holds today; and

WHEREAS, Verdia Haywood has worked diligently and faithfully over the years to make human services more accessible to the people who need them; he oversees several county departments and is a liaison to several boards, authorities, and commissions; and

WHEREAS, Verdia Haywood brought together service providers for the homeless and successfully competed for millions of federal dollars to build transitional and permanent supportive housing; and

WHEREAS, a visionary and creative leader, Verdia Haywood created the Consolidated Community Fund Pool, which brought new coherence to Fairfax County's method of investing in nonprofit organizations; and

WHEREAS, Verdia Haywood has also facilitated the community-driven response to emerging issues with the creation of the Long Term Care Task Force and the Community Interfaith Liaison; and

WHEREAS, Verdia Haywood's commitment to efficient and innovative government services has increased the quality of service Fairfax County offers to its citizens in need of human services and provides a model for other local governments; now, therefore, be it
