3. Committee: Passed in both houses

4. Title: **Special hunting permits; issued to patients from veterans or military hospitals.**

5. Summary: The bill allows the Director of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to permit any organized group of patients residing in or receiving outpatient treatment from a veterans or military hospital to hunt without having to obtain a license on any lands of the Commonwealth where it is otherwise legal to do so. Currently, the director may only issue a special permit to allow such a group of persons to fish without a license in the public waters of the Commonwealth.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The fiscal impact is indeterminate.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: If veteran or military hospital patients are exempted from having to obtain a hunting license then there may be a slight decrease in the number of licenses issued. The revenue impact of the decrease is unknown.
