5.	<b>Summary:</b> The bill allows the Director of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to permit any organized group of patients residing in or receiving outpatient treatment from a veterans or military hospital to hunt without having to obtain a license on any lands of the Commonwealth where it is otherwise legal to do so. Currently, the director may only issue special permit to allow such a group of persons to fish without a license in the public water of the Commonwealth.
