4. Title: Language change eliminating the requirement for the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia to complete a model institutional crisis and emergency management

5. Summary: Eliminates the requirement that the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) must develop and revise, as it deems necessary, a model institutional crisis and emergency management plan for the purpose of assisting public and private two- and four-year institutions of higher education in establishing, operating, and maintaining emergency services and disaster preparedness activities.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Given that the Department of Emergency Management already supports the higher education institutions on disaster preparedness, there is no need for SCHEV to continue having this responsibility. The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia may be able to reprogram personnel costs to other priority areas due to the elimination of this requirement.
