5. Summary: Provides that the governing boards of each public institution of higher education must implement policies that apply to students who are called to active military duty during an academic semester to insure academic credit.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation requires the Boards of Visitors at each public institution to develop policies to grant students called to active military duty the opportunity to receive full academic credit. It is anticipated this would have little fiscal impact to the colleges and universities.
