**5. Summary:** Provides for the suspension of the driver's license of any minor who has 10 or more unexcused absences from public school on consecutive school days.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Supreme Court of Virginia (SCV), it is anticipated that this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the court system due to additional hearings that would be brought in the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Courts. Since the number of cases this bill could generate is unknown and the fiscal impact of fines from the violation of § 46.2-301 is a subset of the number of cases generated by this legislation, the revenue impact from any additional fines cannot be estimated.
