2. Patron: Crockett-Stark

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Corrections; payment of costs associated with prisoner keep.

5. Summary: Increases from \$1 to \$5 per day the amount a jail may charge an inmate to defray the costs associated with the inmate's keep, and clarifies how such fees shall be deposited for regional jails.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: *Final.*

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Compensation Board does not expect this legislation to have a fiscal impact on the agency or the state. Although some jails might generate additional revenue from this action, other payments to the jail from inmates might suffer. For example, this increased fee might reduce the inmates' ability to make medical co-payments or commissary purchases which generate revenues for the jails.
