7. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** Yes. HB 1600/SB 850 recommends removal of funding for this commission from the Department of Education (DOW), therefore it would need to be established in the legislative branch. The legislation indicates that expenses should be paid from existing appropriations or, if unfunded, shall be approved by the Joint Rules Committee.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** Funding for the commission in Chapter 879 was at \$81,000 and since this legislation does not change the composition of the commission, the \$81,000 would need to be transferred to establish the commission in the legislative branch.

The legislation does permit the commission to accept gifts, grants, or donations.
