4. Title: Water Facilities Revolving Loan Fund

5. Summary: The bill authorizes the Virginia Resources Authority to provide a portion of the fees it receives for administering the Virginia Water Facilities Revolving Loan Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality to cover some of that agency's costs for administering the construction assistance loan program.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill does not establish a new fee or increase an existing fee. It allows the Department of Environmental Quality to share an existing fee already being collected by the Virginia Resources Authority. The funding will be used to support the construction assistance loan program.
