4. Title: Crash prevention courses for those 55 years and older

5. Summary: This bill provides that crash prevention courses for individuals age 55 and older may be taken on-line through computer based instruction, as well as allowing insurers to offer discounts for these courses.

6. No fiscal impact. Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill requires insurance companies to provide a discount on motor vehicle liability insurance for individuals age 55 and older who complete a crash prevention course taught through classroom instruction. It also provides insurance companies discretion in offering a discount for courses taught through computer based instruction.

This legislation would have no fiscal impact on the operations of the Department of Motor Vehicles.
