3. Committee: Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Crash prevention courses for those 55 years and older

5. Summary: This bill provides that crash prevention courses for individuals age 55 and older may be taken on-line through computer based instruction, as well as allowing insurers to offer discounts for these courses.

6. No fiscal impact. Preliminary.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The original bill required insurance companies to provide a discount on motor vehicle liability insurance for individuals age 55 and older who complete a crash prevention course through computer based instruction. The substitute bill requires insurance companies to provide the discount for courses taught through classroom instruction, but provides insurance companies discretion in providing the discount for courses taught through computer based instruction.

This legislation would have no fiscal impact on the operations of the Department of Motor Vehicles.
