4. Title: Medication aide training programs; required registration delayed

5. Summary: This bill sets forth requirements for Board of Nursing approved education and training programs for medication aides, and provides that any person who has successfully completed a training program approved by the Board of Nursing may administer medications that would normally be self administered to residents of an assisted living facility until August 1, 2009. This bill also delays enforcement of the requirement for medication aides to be registered until August 1, 2009, and is effective retroactively to January 1, 2009.
