4. Title: Disposition of surplus materials; certain laptop computers.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of General Services to establish procedures that allow members of the General Assembly, in accordance with rules established by the Joint Rules Committee, to purchase, at a reasonable cost not to exceed the trade-in value for such equipment, the laptop computers, software, and related peripheral equipment provided to them by the respective clerk of the House of Delegates or the Senate of Virginia.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Cannot be determined. See Item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation would enable legislators to purchase state owned laptops, software and related peripheral equipment at prices to be determined, but not greater than, the "trade in value". The current process to sell state property through the Commonwealth's surplus property program uses a competitive bidding process yielding market driven revenue for the Commonwealth. It is unclear whether the "trade in value" to be set for the items or the market value from the sale of the items would result in higher or lower revenue for the Commonwealth.
