4. Title: Virginia Consumer Protection Act; recalled products

5. Summary: The substitute bill provides that it is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act to sell, offer for sale, or manufacture for sale a children's product recalled by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission. The provision does not apply to children's products that are used, secondhand, or "seconds."

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services will absorb any costs associated with investigation of violations.
