4. Title: Virginia Retirement System; superintendents and sworn officers of regional jails.

5. Summary: Virginia Retirement System; superintendents and sworn officers of regional jails. Requires localities participating in the Virginia Retirement System and participating in a regional jail to provide retirement benefits comparable to the benefits provided to state police officers to the regional jail's superintendent (1.85% benefit multiplier, 50/25 age and service requirement for unreduced benefits and the annual supplement payable until the member is eligible for unreduced Social Security benefits) and sworn officers (1.70% benefit multiplier, 50/25 age and service requirement for unreduced benefits and the annual supplement payable until the member is eligible for unreduced Social Security benefits and the annual supplement payable until the member is eligible for unreduced Social Security benefits and the annual supplement payable until the member is eligible for unreduced Social Security benefits. Regional Jails may elect to provide a 1.85% benefit multiplier for the sworn officers.
