4. Title: **Accreditation of schools; delayed implementation of certain statutes and regulations, etc**

5. Summary: Provides for the delayed implementation of statutes, regulations, and standards upon which the accreditation of schools or school divisions in the Commonwealth is based that are not already in effect on June 30, 2008, until July 1, 2010.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation delays implementation of any statutes or regulations prescribing additional requirements for graduation or accreditation of schools until July 1, 2010 (fiscal year 2011), unless such statutes or regulations are required by federal code, federal regulation, or court action. By delaying implementation of any new statutes or regulations, any costs associated with them would not be realized until the 2010-2012 biennium. Therefore, this legislation will have no fiscal impact in the current biennium.
