8. Fiscal Implications: According to DCJS, the first year cost for starting this program at DCJS would be \$80,250. Establishing this new program at DCJS would involve going through the Administrative Process Act (APA) to develop the training rules that animal control officers would be required to follow. This process would involve a series of public meetings with the advisory board as designated in the legislation to gather the information necessary to promulgate the training rules. From a technology standpoint, modifications will be needed to agency electronic tracking systems to allow DCJS to track animal control officers and their training. A majority of the funding needed to carryout this legislation would be to fund an additional position.
