5. Summary: Requires the annual report of expenditures provided by the school board to the appropriate governing body to also be made available to the public on an official website or hard copy at the central school division office, on a template prescribed by the Board of Education.

6. No fiscal impact. Preliminary.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation requires school divisions to make an annual expenditure report, on template prescribed by the Board of Education, available to the public. Local school boards can make this report available on the official website for the school division, if one exists, or in hard copy at the central office of the school division.

This legislation could generate some additional administrative costs for local school divisions. However, the Department of Education anticipates such costs can be absorbed within current resources.
