**4. Title:** Internet sex offender registry information.

**5. Summary:** Requires that the Internet sex offender registry information include a “wanted” notation for a person who is wanted for any crime. Currently, the “wanted” notation is only posted for a person who is wanted for failing to register.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of State Police, the proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact since the department plans to develop a manual policy to ensure sex offender registrants have any wanted criminal offenses identified.

However, a programmatic cost could occur if the intent of this legislation is to have sex offenders identified along with their wanted criminal offenses on the Sex Offender Registry website. This additional cost is not known at this time. Currently, the department does not list wanted crimes on the webpage.
