3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Establish penalty for text messaging and emailing while driving.

5. Summary: This bill prohibits operation of a motor vehicle, bicycle, electric personal assistive mobility device, electric power-assisted bicycle, or moped on the Commonwealth's highways while using any wireless telecommunications device for the purpose of composing or sending a text message or email. Exemptions are provided for persons lawfully parked or stopped, the use of global positioning systems (GPS), and the use of a wireless telecommunications device to report an emergency. The provisions of this bill do not apply to operators of emergency vehicles.
