A BILL to designate the U.S. Route 29 bridge over the Rapidan River between Greene and Madison Counties the "Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge in honor of Corporal Adam J. Fargo and Private First Class Edwin A. Andino," to designate the U.S. Route 340 bridge over the South Fork of the Shenandoah River at the Warren County/Page County line the "Larry E. Smedley Veterans Memorial Bridge," and to designate the U.S. Route 340/Virginia Route 522 bridge over the North Fork of the Shenandoah River in Warren County the "Wesley L. Fox Veterans Memorial Bridge."

8. Fiscal implications: The cost of signage will be recovered from the respective counties as follows:

The cost for signs on the U.S. Route 29 bridge over the Rapidan River is estimated at $\$ 1000$ for 2 complex, large signs. The cost will be shared equally by Greene and Madison Counties.

The cost of the signs on the Route 340 bridge over the South Fork of the Shenandoah River is estimated at $\$ 800$ for 2 signs, sustained by Page and/or Warren Counties.

The cost for signs on the U.S. Route 340/Virginia Route 522 bridge over the North Fork of the Shenandoah River, estimated at $\$ 800$ for 2 signs, sustained entirely by Warren County.
