**4. Title:** Department of Health Professions; submission of information

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation expands the requirement to submit certain information to the Department of Health Professions to anyone applying for initial licensure, certification, registration, or a multistate licensure privilege, and individuals licensed, certified, registered, or holding a multistate licensure privilege issued by a health regulatory board. Also the bill allows the Department, and the Board of Nursing, to release any information for the purposes of determining shortage designations and to qualified personnel if pertinent to an investigation, research, or study, provided a written agreement between such qualified personnel and the Department that provides that any person to whom such information is divulged shall preserve the confidentiality of the information, is executed.
