**4. Title:** Holocaust education; middle and high schools

**5. Summary:** Requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction to select and distribute a teacher's manual that emphasizes the causes and ramification of the Holocaust and genocide. Also, each local school division is required to provide the grade-appropriate portions of the manual to history and literature teachers of these classes.

**6. No fiscal impact.** Final. See item 8.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Education (DOE) anticipates being able to use an existing manual developed by another entity to meet the provisions of this bill. An electronic version of the manual is available to DOE for this purpose at no additional cost. It is assumed the distribution of this manual to school divisions can be achieved through an electronically transmitted memorandum from DOE. Therefore, it is anticipated this legislation will not have a fiscal impact to the state.
