This legislation will allow the Foundation to also expend funds to reduce childhood obesity. The Foundation's board is specifically charged with primarily using MSA funds for discouraging tobacco use and obtaining other private and grant funding to reduce childhood obesity. This legislation will not alter the overall budget for the Foundation or create the need for additional resources.
