**5. Summary:** Adds patient street address and city or county to and removes patient relationship to insured from the list of information that must be reported by hospitals, facilities, physicians, and oral and maxillofacial surgeons.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Virginia Department of Health and Virginia Health Information

Other Comments:** The legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact for the Department of Health or Virginia Health Information, the nonprofit organization which administers the patient level data system. The information reported by hospitals, facilities, physicians, and oral and maxillofacial surgeons are submitted directly to the Virginia Health Information and are used for the intended purposes of the patient level data system.

The engrossed legislation removes the patient's employment status from the list of information reported to Virginia Health Information. This fiscal impact does not differ from the one issued for the introduced legislation.
