- 5. Summary: Consumer Real Estate Settlement Protection Act; disclosures. Adds § 6.1-2.21:1 to CRESPA to clarify that the purchaser or borrower has the right to select a settlement agent and that the seller may not require the use of a particular settlement agent as a condition of the sale of the property. The bill also amends § 6.1-2.22 to change the disclosure language required to be in residential real estate contracts to clarify that the purchaser or borrower has the right to select the settlement agent that will handle the closing of the transaction. It also adds language to the disclosure to state that the provisions of CRESPA may not be varied by an agreement between the parties, that any rights conferred by CRESPA may not be waived and that the seller may not require the use of a particular settlement agent as a condition of the sale of the property.
