4. Title: Arrest of Illegal Immigrants

5. Summary: Removes Code provision that prohibits an arrest of an illegal alien (who has been previously convicted of a felony and deported) more frequently than once every six months except where confirmation has been received from Immigration and Customs Enforcement that the arrested person will be taken into federal custody.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Supreme Court of Virginia, this legislation would likely cause an increase in the number of hearings however it is not known how many additional cases would be generated. The number of additional hearings is assumed to be small and should be able to be accommodated utilizing current court resources.

According to the Compensation Board, the jail association foresees no material fiscal impact based on the legislation.
