4. Title: Conservation and Recreation, Department of; power to establish non-competitively procured contracts

5. Summary: The bill grants the Department of Conservation and Recreation power to establish non-competitively procured contracts with non-profit organizations that wish to conduct revenue producing activities on Department lands for the benefit of Virginia state parks or the natural area preserve system.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact. See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill will allow non-profit organizations, such as "Friends of the Park" group to conduct revenue generating activities at state parks for the benefit of the parks or natural area preserve system. The bill may result in minimal cost savings or cost avoidance for the parks.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Conservation and Recreation.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The bill specifies that the provisions do not apply to capital improvement contracts.
