- **5. Summary:** The bill delays conveyance of the property until July 1, 2010.
- 6. Fiscal impact estimates are indeterminate.
- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes, Item 143.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** Delay in conveyance of property will impose additional maintenance and security costs while under the state's jurisdiction. The Virginia School for the Deaf, Blind, and Multi-disabled is no longer operational and no funding is allocated to the agency in FY 2010. Current budget language instructs the Department of Education and the Department of General Services to determine how to dispose of the property.

Projected FY 2010 Cost = \$221,000

Utilities \$180,000 (\$15,000 per month)

Grass cutting \$1,000 Security \$40,000

The projections do not include contingency for emergency repairs to campus buildings.
