**4. Title:** Department of Minority Business Enterprise; name change.

**5. Summary:** Changes the name of the Department of Minority Business Enterprise to the Department of Supplier Diversity and Procurement Advocacy with responsibility for the Department with the Secretary of Administration. The bill also clarifies that small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses must be comprised of individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and that both the management and daily business operations are conducted by such individuals. The bill contains technical amendments.
