4. Title: **Crash prevention courses for those 55 years and older**

5. Summary: Provides that crash prevention courses for individuals age 55 and older may be taken on-line through computer based instruction.

6. Fiscal impact estimates: No fiscal impact. See Item 8 below.

8. Fiscal implications:

Under §38.2-2217, a reduction in premiums for motor vehicle liability insurance is allowed for individuals age 55 and older who complete crash prevention courses. The intent of this legislation is to allow these individuals to take these courses on-line through computer based instruction.

This legislation would have no fiscal impact on DMV operations.
