**4. Title:** Child support enforcement order; eliminates requirement obligor & obligee maintain marital domicile

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation eliminates requirement that an obligor and obligee must have maintained a marital domicile in the Commonwealth in order for the Department of Social Services to establish an administrative support order on an out-of-state obligor. This bill also extends the time limit for service of notice of an order to withhold funds in a joint account of an obligor from 21 to 45 days.
