**4. Title:** Insurers; annual statements.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Gives the State Corporation Commission the discretion to permit insurers to file their annual financial statements electronically.

**11. Other comments:** Senate Bill 1044 was introduced at the request of the State Corporation Commission Bureau of Insurance. The Code of Virginia has for years required the filing of paper copies of insurer financial statements. With this bill, the Commission will be following the lead of 43 states and the District of Columbia, which allow insurers to make financial filings electronically with the central repository for insurer financial information, the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. Insurers that do not wish to make their filings electronically may request an exemption from the Commission pursuant to existing language in § 38.2-1300 of the Code of Virginia.
