4. Title: Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Commission

5. Summary: The bill extends the sunset provision for the commission from July 1, 2009 to July 1, 2014. In addition, the bill also adds to the powers and duties of the commission to develop and promote strategies to encourage brain health and recognize cognitive decline.

6. No Fiscal Impact

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill has no fiscal impact as it only extends the life of the commission by five more years. The costs of the commission are already budgeted so an extension imposes no costs on the Commonwealth. While the bill does add an additional requirement on the commission, it does not create additional costs. Any additional work of the commission will be handled within existing resources.
