4. Title: Establish the non-use of safety belts as a primary offense.

5. Summary: This bill makes failure to use safety belts and shoulder harnesses a primary offense not requiring due cause by the police officer to stop the vehicle for some other violation of the *Code of Virginia* or local ordinance.

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how many violations could result from this proposed legislation. However, any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited in the Literary Fund.
