5. Summary: Add to the duties of the State Executive Council (SEC) requirements to analyze and then report on expenditures associated with children who do not receive pool funding and have emotional and behavioral problems. The bill also requires the Council to identify funding streams used to purchase services in addition to pooled, Medicaid, and Title IV-E funding. Both reporting requirements can be included in the biennial state progress report (filed in odd number years) on comprehensive services to children, youth, and families delivered to the General Assembly and community policy and management teams.
