## 4. Title: Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System; reemployment after prior election of benefits

- **5. Summary:** Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System; reemployment after prior election of benefits. Makes changes to the election of retirement benefits for employees in the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System on July 1, 2001. The substitute provides if an employee at the time elected to take a compensation supplement, the employee was eligible to receive the supplement at the time he ceased employment, and the employee ceased employment and was reemployed in the system after a break in service not exceeding twelve months, such employee would be eligible to keep his original election of the supplement in lieu of a two-percent compensation multiplier if the member met certain eligibility requirements.
